

Answer:

Do you need accreditation, approval, and permission from Satan to rule the House of God? Do you need accreditation, approval, and permission from Satan to teach the Word of God? Let us consider the following verses to confirm our doctrine:

Acts 5:36 (KJV) For before these days rose up Theudas, boasting himself to be somebody; to whom a number of men, about four hundred, joined themselves: who was slain; and all, as many as obeyed him, were scattered, and brought to nought.

Acts 5:37 (KJV) After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, *even* as many as obeyed him, were dispersed.

Acts 5:38 (KJV) And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought:

Acts 5:39 (KJV) But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God.

This is Satan, the Government attempting to issue Government Accreditation to the Apostles before they can teach the Word of God but the Apostles rejected the Government and “daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ”!

Acts 5:40 (KJV) And to him they agreed: and when they had called the apostles, and beaten *them*, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go.

Acts 5:41 (KJV) And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name.

Acts 5:42 (KJV) And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.

I was talking with one Professor of Religion in Ghana and he asked me the Accreditation for The Bible University among other things.

When I explained to him the two separate entities of Secular education diplomas and Religious education and their certificates, he insisted that even so, people still expect a religious educational establishment to be accredited by the National Accreditation Board.

Matthew 22:45 (KJV) **If David then call him Lord, how is he his son?**

Matthew 22:46 (KJV) And no man was able to answer him a word, neither durst any *man* from that day forth ask him any more *questions*.

Now, what Jesus Christ was teaching the foolish and ignorant highly qualified and highly educated Pharisees and Sadducees in **Matthew 22:41-46 (KJV)** was that how can a father call his son Lord? In other words, how can the higher entity call the lower entity Lord? On the other hand, how can the inferior secular Government of Satan accredit and approve and allow the superior Spiritual Government of Jesus Christ?

Matthew 12:29 (KJV) Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.

Acts 4:5 (KJV) And it came to pass on the morrow, that their rulers, and elders, and scribes,

Acts 4:6 (KJV) And Annas the high priest, and Caiaphas, and John, and Alexander, and as many as were of the kindred of the high priest, were gathered together at Jerusalem.

Acts 4:7 (KJV) And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this?

Acts 4:8 (KJV) Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel,

Acts 4:9 (KJV) If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole;

Acts 4:10 (KJV) Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, *even* by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

Acts 4:11 (KJV) This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner.

Acts 4:12 (KJV) Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Acts 4:13 (KJV) Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

Acts 4:14 (KJV) And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.

Acts 4:15 (KJV) But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves,

Acts 4:16 (KJV) Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them *is* manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny *it*.

Acts 4:17 (KJV) But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name.

Acts 4:18 (KJV) And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.

Acts 4:19 (KJV) But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye.

Acts 4:20 (KJV) For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.

For example, when a religious establishment strays from the Great Commission and mandate of Jesus Christ in **Matthew 28:18-20 (KJV)** to now begin to teach History of Religions, Church Government, Church Administration, Accounting, Human Resources, secular University Research Methods, Principles of Warehousing, Hospital Care, Elderly Care, Financial Management, Investment, and so on and so forth, then surely, that religious establishment has brought itself under the rule of Satan, and therefore needs a Government Accreditation for those subjects, courses, and academic programs that it is running alongside its purely Christian and Biblical Training of Ministers! Philippians 3:8 (KJV) Yea doubtless, and I count all things *but* loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them *but* dung, that I may win Christ,

Philippians 3:9 (KJV) And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:

Philippians 3:10 (KJV) That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

Philippians 3:11 (KJV) If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.

While the true Ministers of Jesus Christ dedicated themselves ONLY to the teaching Ministry of the Word of God and of Jesus Christ, you are today revealing yourselves as false and evil Ministers of Satan by teaching things outside the Gospel and Testimony of Jesus Christ? Has the hand of the LORD God Almighty become too short for you foolish Ministers of Jesus Christ that you now seek the instruments of Satan to rule the House of God? Has the wisdom of the LORD God Almighty run dry for you foolish Ministers of Jesus Christ that you now seek the wisdom of the world and of Satan to rule the House of God? 1 Corinthians 6:6 (KJV) But brother goeth to law with brother, and that before the unbelievers.

Have you not so much as read the Bible at all that Jesus Christ rejected the accreditation/approval/and permission of the Government? Do ye not at all know that the Government from whom you seek accreditation and approval fears and trembles before the superior power that called you into Ministry? And today you seek to reject Jesus Christ by doing the very opposite of what He taught? Curse be on you then!

John 19:9 (KJV) And went again into the judgment hall, and saith unto Jesus, Whence art thou? But Jesus gave him no answer.

John 19:10 (KJV) Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee?

John 19:11 (KJV) Jesus answered, **Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.**

John 19:12 (KJV) And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Caesar.

The Departments of Religions in the worldly Universities and all the Bible Colleges that combine worldly Courses and Bible teachings need Government Accreditation because they are not doing purely and exactly what Jesus Christ commanded to do! They are like the corrupt Pharisees and Sadducees and the Rulers of the Synagogues who were there in the time of Jesus Christ in Jerusalem, but Jesus Christ did not use any of them but rather shunned them, why? Matthew 16:5 (KJV) And when his disciples were come to the other side, they had forgotten to take bread.

Matthew 16:7 (KJV) And they reasoned among themselves, saying, *It is* because we have taken no bread.

Matthew 16:8 (KJV) *Which* when Jesus perceived, he said unto them, O ye of little faith, why reason ye among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread?

Matthew 16:9 (KJV) Do ye not yet understand, neither remember the five loaves of the five thousand, and how many baskets ye took up?

Matthew 16:10 (KJV) Neither the seven loaves of the four thousand, and how many baskets ye took up?

Matthew 16:11 (KJV) How is it that ye do not understand that I spake *it* not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?

Matthew 16:12 (KJV) Then understood they how that he bade *them* not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

The same we have today with all the Bible Colleges and the Departments of Religions in the worldly Universities that offer both secular courses and Bible Courses! Jesus Christ shunned them and established His own Bible University that taught only the Bible the Word of God! So, if that is what you want, then go there, but we in the true Bible University of the Bible, we shall teach ONLY the Word of God the Scriptures from Genesis to Revelation! That is the Jesus method and footstep that we follow in The Bible University! Deuteronomy 4:1 (KJV) Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the statutes and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do *them*, that ye may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers giveth you.

Deuteronomy 4:14 (KJV) And the LORD commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and judgments, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go over to possess it.

Deuteronomy 5:31 (KJV) But as for thee, stand thou here by me, and I will speak unto thee all the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which thou shalt teach them, that they may do *them* in the land which I give them to possess it.

Deuteronomy 6:1 (KJV) Now these *are* the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do *them* in the land whither ye go to possess it:

1 Samuel 12:23 (KJV) Moreover as for me, God forbid that I should sin against the LORD in ceasing to pray for you: but I will teach you the good and the right way:

2 Chronicles 17:7 (KJV) Also in the third year of his reign he sent to his princes, *even* to Ben-hail, and to Obadiah, and to Zechariah, and to Nethaneel, and to Michaiah, to teach in the cities of Judah.

Ezra 7:10 (KJV) For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do *it*, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.

Matthew 11:1 (KJV) And it came to pass, when Jesus had made an end of commanding his twelve disciples, he departed thence to teach and to preach in their cities.

Mark 4:1 (KJV) And he began again to teach by the sea side: and there was gathered unto him a great multitude, so that he entered into a ship, and sat in the sea; and the whole multitude was by the sea on the land.

Mark 6:2 (KJV) And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing *him* were astonished, saying, From whence hath this *man* these things? and what wisdom *is* this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

Mark 6:34 (KJV) And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.

Luke 11:1 (KJV) And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.

Luke 12:12 (KJV) For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.

John 14:26 (KJV) But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

1 Timothy 3:2 (KJV) A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;

Here is the evidence that Jesus Christ shunned all The Bible University Professors and Bible Colleges and the Departments of Religions during His time and established His own Bible University that taught ONLY the Word of God!

Luke 19:47 (KJV) And he taught daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy him,

John 7:14 (KJV) Now about the midst of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and taught.

John 7:15 (KJV) And the Jews marvelled, saying, How knoweth this man letters, having never learned?

John 7:16 (KJV) Jesus answered them, and said, *My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.*

John 7:17 (KJV) *If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself.*

John 7:18 (KJV) *He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but he that seeketh his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him.*

John 7:19 (KJV) *Did not Moses give you the law, and yet none of you keepeth the law? Why go ye about to kill me?*

John 9:39 (KJV) And Jesus said, *For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.*

John 9:40 (KJV) And *some* of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, Are we blind also?

John 9:41 (KJV) Jesus said unto them, *If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.*

John 18:19 (KJV) The high priest then asked Jesus of his disciples, and of his doctrine.

John 18:20 (KJV) Jesus answered him, *I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.*

John 18:21 (KJV) *Why askest thou me? ask them which heard me, what I have said unto them: behold, they know what I said.*

John 18:22 (KJV) And when he had thus spoken, one of the officers which stood by struck Jesus with the palm of his hand, saying, Answerest thou the high priest so?

John 18:23 (KJV) Jesus answered him, *If I have spoken evil, bear witness of the evil: but if well, why smitest thou me?*

Here is the evidence that reveals that when you teach anything other than the Gospel of Jesus Christ, then you are not a true and correct Bible University!

Galatians 1:8 (KJV) But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

Galatians 1:9 (KJV) As we said before, so say I now again, If any *man* preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

1 Timothy 6:3 (KJV) If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, *even* the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;

2 Timothy 2:2 (KJV) And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

Here is evidence of the true and correct Bible University in the Bible and they taught ONLY the Word of God!

Acts 18:9 (KJV) Then spake the Lord to Paul in the night by a vision, **Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace:**

Acts 18:10 (KJV) **For I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city.**

Acts 18:11 (KJV) And he continued *there* a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them.

Acts 19:8 (KJV) And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of God.

Acts 19:9 (KJV) But when divers were hardened, and believed not, but spake evil of that way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, disputing daily in the school of one Tyrannus.

Acts 19:10 (KJV) And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.

Acts 23:11 (KJV) And the night following the Lord stood by him, and said, **Be of good cheer, Paul: for as thou hast testified of me in Jerusalem, so must thou bear witness also at Rome.**

Stay ONLY with the Great Commission in **Matthew 28:18-20 (KJV)**, stay with only what Jesus Christ commanded you to do, never leave the commandment of Jesus Christ aside to turn to the left or to the right one bit, never go to seek or to teach other things that Jesus Christ never told you to do, and it shall be well with you, leave the things and courses and teachings of the world to Satan and focus only on what Jesus Christ commanded you, and it shall be well with you and your house. But if ye rebel as ye all foolish Ministers with Government Accreditation presently do, then know for certain, that ye shall all surely perish in Hell!

CHAPTER 5

ACCREDITATION

The following section of the United States Constitution prohibits the Federal Government of America and the State Governments from accrediting any Bible College and from exercising any authority, jurisdiction, or attempt to regulate the doctrine and teaching of the Holy Bible!

RELIGION AND FREE EXPRESSION

FIRST AMENDMENT

“Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.”

Article VI of the United States Constitution specifies that:

“No religious Test shall ever be required as a Qualification to any Office or public Trust under the United States.”

The Bible University is legally registered, incorporated, and authorized to offer the following Christian educational services to the public as a Christian Educational Institution in the United States of America, specifically to offer the following:

1. Teaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ
2. Training of Pastors in Bible Theology
3. Training of Pastors in Pastoral Accountability
4. Christian Education
5. Charitable Programs for the poor and needy, and
6. Provide a holistic approach to Christian Care via Pharmacy and Health Center Services.

The Bible University is legally registered, incorporated, and authorized to operate as a Christian Educational Institution in Ghana to offer the same services listed above as approved in the USA.

The Bible University is legally registered, incorporated, and authorized to operate as a Christian Educational Institution in South Africa to offer the same services listed above as approved in the USA.

Accreditation is a form of endorsement that Colleges and Universities use to let students know that you can obtain a valid education from enrolling in their programs.

There is no specific accreditation that guarantees employment after graduation, transfer of credits to other similar institutions, or future success.

University Accreditation is a collegial process based on self and peer assessment, for the purpose of improving academic quality and public accountability.

CHAPTER 6

THE DOCTRINE OF ACCREDITATION

Question 2206

The Doctrine of Accreditation!

Answer:

Accreditation is an approval given to a person or an entity as a means to assure the public that what the person or entity is doing in the public space is correct, genuine, accepted, approved, and according to expectations.

Therefore, all educational institutions that are engaged in offering education, courses, teaching, and lessons to the public seek their accreditation from the Government of the land as required by their Constitution.

Specifically, there are three groups of educational institutions namely:

1. Secular schools
2. Religious schools
3. Hybrid school

Secular schools are all the schools combined where their declared mission and objectives are not to focus only on teaching the Word of God the Holy Bible. They may teach Religion as an elective but Bible Courses are not their main work at all.

Purely religious schools are all the schools where their declared aim is to teach only the Word of God the Holy Bible or whatever they claim to be their Holy Book.

Then, there are hybrid schools that combine secular and religious instruction, in other words, these hybrid schools teach both secular subjects such as Accounting, Business, and Geography and they also teach the Holy Bible. They may even have a Christian name but they do not teach only Christian subjects. Example of such educational institutions are: The Catholic University, The Pentecost University, The Central University, and so on and so forth.

Secular schools and hybrid schools require Government accreditation to operate and offer services to the public.

However, the Constitution of most countries prohibit the Government from exercising any authority or control over purely religious schools hence, such purely religious schools do not need any Government accreditation nor approval nor regulation on what they may teach from the Holy Bible and how they may teach the Holy Bible. Here are the reasons:

1. There is a constitutional and legal provision for the Separation of Church and State hence the Church does not meddle in State affairs and politics while the State does not meddle in Church affairs! Let us consider the following verses to confirm our doctrine:
 - i. **John 18:28 (KJV)** Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be defiled; but that they might eat the passover.
 - ii. **John 18:29 (KJV)** Pilate then went out unto them, and said, What accusation bring ye against this man?
 - iii. **John 18:30 (KJV)** They answered and said unto him, If he were not a malefactor, we would not have delivered him up unto thee.
 - iv. **John 18:31 (KJV)** Then said Pilate unto them, Take ye him, and judge him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death:
 - v. **Acts 18:12 (KJV)** And when Gallio was the deputy of Achaia, the Jews made insurrection with one accord against Paul, and brought him to the judgment seat,
 - vi. **Acts 18:13 (KJV)** Saying, This *fellow* persuadeth men to worship God contrary to the law.
 - vii. **Acts 18:14 (KJV)** And when Paul was now about to open *his* mouth, Gallio said unto the Jews, If it were a matter of wrong or wicked lewdness, O ye Jews, reason would that I should bear with you:

- viii. **Acts 18:15 (KJV)** But if it be a question of words and names, and *of* your law, look ye *to it*; for I will be no judge of such *matters*.
 - ix. **Acts 18:16 (KJV)** And he drave them from the judgment seat.
2. The Word of God the Holy Bible considers all the wisdom of the world as foolishness and considers the Word of God as wisdom hence, foolishness cannot evaluate, assess, examine, accredit, regulate, nor approve wisdom!
- i. **1 Corinthians 1:20 (KJV)** Where *is* the wise? where *is* the scribe? where *is* the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?
 - ii. **1 Corinthians 2:6 (KJV)** Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought:
 - iii. **1 Corinthians 3:19 (KJV)** For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.
3. While the Word of God is teaching wisdom, all the schools in the world are teaching foolishness, therefore, fools cannot examine and accredit wise men!
- i. **1 Corinthians 2:10 (KJV)** But God hath revealed *them* unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.
 - ii. **1 Corinthians 2:11 (KJV)** For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.
 - iii. **1 Corinthians 2:12 (KJV)** Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
 - iv. **1 Corinthians 2:13 (KJV)** Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

- v. **1 Corinthians 2:14 (KJV)** But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.
4. When you compare an Anointed Bible Professor to an Academic Professor from the University, a Politician, a Government Appointee, or a Court Judge, the Anointed Bible Professor is superior therefore; the inferior cannot control, regulate, approve, nor accredit the superior!
- i. **1 Corinthians 2:15 (KJV)** But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.
 - ii. **Acts 4:15 (KJV)** But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves,
 - iii. **Acts 4:16 (KJV)** Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them *is* manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny *it*.
 - iv. **Acts 4:17 (KJV)** But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name.
 - v. **Acts 4:18 (KJV)** And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.
 - vi. **Acts 4:19 (KJV)** But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye.
 - vii. **Acts 4:20 (KJV)** For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.
 - viii. **Acts 4:21 (KJV)** So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all *men* glorified God for that which was done.
5. The Word of God is spiritual and comes by revelation, not by academic pursuit and the Government has no power, jurisdiction, or understanding in spiritual and revelation matters!

- i. **John 6:63 (KJV)** *It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing; the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.*
 - ii. **Romans 7:14 (KJV)** For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.
 - iii. **2 Timothy 3:16 (KJV)** All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:
 - iv. **2 Peter 1:21 (KJV)** For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake *as they were* moved by the Holy Ghost.
- 6. The requirement that Government and Politicians have no business meddling in Church matters, or trying to control, regulate, approve, nor accredit churches is enshrined in the Holy Bible!
 - i. **Matthew 21:23 (KJV)** And when he was come into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came unto him as he was teaching, and said, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority?
 - ii. **Mark 11:27 (KJV)** And they come again to Jerusalem: and as he was walking in the temple, there come to him the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders,
 - iii. **Matthew 21:24 (KJV)** And Jesus answered and said unto them, *I also will ask you one thing, which if ye tell me, I in like wise will tell you by what authority I do these things.*
 - iv. **Matthew 21:25 (KJV)** *The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men?* And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him?
 - v. **Matthew 21:26 (KJV)** But if we shall say, Of men; we fear the people; for all hold John as a prophet.
 - vi. **Matthew 21:27 (KJV)** And they answered Jesus, and said, We cannot tell. And he said unto them, *Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.*

7. The rod of correction, of examination, of accreditation, and of judgement is with the Minister of Jesus Christ and not with the Government Minister! It is therefore an abomination and a serious contradiction to have the servant (Government Minister) accredit the Master (Minister of Jesus Christ)! If you are a Bible College and you are teaching ONLY the Word of God the Holy Bible, then it is an unrighteous thing to seek accreditation from a wicked and worldly Government!
- i. **1 Corinthians 6:1 (KJV)** Dare any of you, having a matter against another, go to law before the unjust, and not before the saints?
 - ii. **1 Corinthians 6:2 (KJV)** Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?
 - iii. **1 Corinthians 6:3 (KJV)** Know ye not that we shall judge angels? how much more things that pertain to this life?
 - iv. **1 Corinthians 6:4 (KJV)** If then ye have judgments of things pertaining to this life, set them to judge who are least esteemed in the church.
 - v. **1 Corinthians 6:5 (KJV)** I speak to your shame. Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you? no, not one that shall be able to judge between his brethren?
 - vi. **1 Corinthians 6:7 (KJV)** Now therefore there is utterly a fault among you, because ye go to law one with another. Why do ye not rather take wrong? why do ye not rather *suffer yourselves* to be defrauded?
 - vii. **1 Corinthians 6:8 (KJV)** Nay, ye do wrong, and defraud, and that *your* brethren.
 - viii. **1 Corinthians 6:9 (KJV)** Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,
 - ix. **1 Corinthians 6:10 (KJV)** Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

Does it then mean that there is no accreditation at all in Bible Teaching? How then shall we know the fake Bible Teachers to avoid them?

Matthew 16:6 (KJV) Then Jesus said unto them, *Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.*

Mark 8:15 (KJV) And he charged them, saying, *Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and of the leaven of Herod.*

Luke 12:1 (KJV) In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, *Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.*

Matthew 23:1 (KJV) Then spake Jesus to the multitude, and to his disciples,

Matthew 23:2 (KJV) Saying, *The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat:*

Matthew 23:3 (KJV) *All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not.*

2 Peter 2:1 (KJV) But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

There is a different form of accreditation in Bible Teaching and it is called Peer-Accreditation! What does Peer-Accreditation mean?

The doctrine of Peer-Accreditation in Bible Teaching actually precedes and is older than the Government Accreditation of secular schools. The concept is the same as you have for a Medical School Regulatory Board where a Medical School

cannot take a non-medical person such as an Accountant or a Politician to come and evaluate their teaching and practise of medicine. Medical Doctors usually take Medical Doctors to assess, evaluate, accredit, and approve themselves, and the same is for Peer-Review Bible Accreditation as we see in the following evidences, especially in **1 Corinthians 14:29 (KJV)**:

Joshua 1:7 (KJV) Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it *to* the right hand or *to* the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

Joshua 1:8 (KJV) This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

Psalms 26:2 (KJV) Examine me, O LORD, and prove me; try my reins and my heart.

1 Corinthians 9:3 (KJV) Mine answer to them that do examine me is this,

Isaiah 8:20 (KJV) To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, *it is* because *there is* no light in them.

Matthew 12:36 (KJV) *But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.*

Luke 16:2 (KJV) *And he called him, and said unto him, How is it that I hear this of thee? give an account of thy stewardship; for thou mayest be no longer steward.*

Acts 17:11 (KJV) These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness

of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

Romans 14:12 (KJV) So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

1 Corinthians 14:29 (KJV) Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.

Ephesians 6:21 (KJV) But that ye also may know my affairs, *and* how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things:

Colossians 4:7 (KJV) All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, *who is* a beloved brother, and a faithful minister and fellowservant in the Lord:

1 Thessalonians 5:21 (KJV) Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.

1 John 4:1 (KJV) Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

Now, since the doctrine of Peer-Accreditation in Bible Teaching relies on Ministers of Jesus Christ, how can a Pastor reach that level to start performing this accrediting function? Here is what you need to do!

Proverbs 15:28 (KJV) The heart of the righteous studieth to answer: but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things.

1 Timothy 4:13 (KJV) Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

2 Timothy 2:15 (KJV) Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

In other words, you need to first be a Master in the Studying and Teaching of the Word of God before you can start correcting other Pastors to teach right!

Luke 6:41 (KJV) And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but perceivest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

Luke 6:42 (KJV) Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.

Luke 6:43 (KJV) For a good tree bringeth not forth corrupt fruit; neither doth a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

Luke 6:44 (KJV) For every tree is known by his own fruit. For of thorns men do not gather figs, nor of a bramble bush gather they grapes.

Luke 6:45 (KJV) A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.

Romans 2:17 (KJV) Behold, thou art called a Jew, and retest in the law, and makest thy boast of God,

Romans 2:18 (KJV) And knowest *his* will, and approvest the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law;

Romans 2:19 (KJV) And art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them which are in darkness,

Open and Distance Learning Standards

SCOPE

1. On-line provision and interactive
2. E-learning and blended learning to open learning
3. Virtual education

- 1. CITATION AND INTERPRETATION** – These Standards and Guidelines are to be used for quality control and quality assurance in higher education offered through distance learning.

These standards shall apply to open and distance learning institutions.

“**CURRICULUM**” means an organized programme of study for a given degree, diploma or certificate awards incorporating all matters such as academic

requirement, duration of programme, admission requirements, programme content requirements and assessment process requirements.

“DISTANCE EDUCATION” means delivery of learning or training to those who are separated mostly by time and space from those who are teaching or training. The teaching is done with a variety of mediating processes used to transmit content, to provide tuition and to conduct assessment or measure outcomes. The delivery modes may include traditional distance education by correspondence courses, on-line provision and interactive CD ROMs, e-learning and blended learning to open learning centers and face-to-face provision where a significant element of flexibility, self-study, and learning support, in an integral part.

“FLEXIBLE LEARNING” means provision of learning opportunities that can be accessed at any place and time. It relates more to scheduling of activities than to any particular delivery mode.

“ONLINE LEARNING AND E-LEARNING” means the application of information and communication technologies (ICTs) to enhance distance education, implement open learning policies, make learning activities more flexible and enable those learning activities more flexible and enable those learning activities to be distributed among many learning venues.

“OPEN LEARNING” means policies and practices that permit entry to learning with no or minimum barriers with respect to age, gender, or time constraints and with recognition or prior learning.

“PROGRAMME OF STUDY” means the prescribed syllabus that students must be taught at each key stage.

“PROVIDER” means an organization that is responsible for providing the educational service, which may be a self-contained organization, a unit embedded within a larger organization, one member of a partnership between one or more organizations, or one aspect of a more wideranging provision offered by a larger organization.

The Provider in this case is THE BIBLE UNIVERSITY, USA

“VIRTUAL EDUCATION” means distance education which is largely web-centered, but does not necessarily limit itself to learners outside a conventional classroom. It uses multimedia and, besides delivering content, also enables a high level of interaction among learners, content, teachers, peers and administration both synchronously and asynchronously.

3.1 NEEDS ASSESSMENT – Who will help us do the Feasibility Study or Needs Assessment document?

The provider shall show evidence that an elaborate needs assessment or feasibility study has been undertaken giving the rationale or justification for setting up the institution or starting the programme as reflected in the philosophy of the provider.

3.2 VISION AND MISSION STATEMENTS OF THE PROVIDER – A provider of open and distance learning shall have clearly stated vision and mission consistent with its philosophy and make it known to its constituents.

3.3 OBJECTIVES AND STRATEGIES OF THE PROVIDER – The provider shall have clearly stated objectives and strategies for achieving their mission.

3.4 GOVERNANCE AND ADMINISTRATION – The provider shall ensure that there is clear governance and administrative structures and involve stakeholders where appropriate.

3.7 MODE OF DELIVERY – The provider shall specify the media that are to be used for basic delivery as well as support to the learners.

In The Bible University, we use Online as our medium for basic delivery and support to the learners.

CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION – The curriculum and instructional methods should ensure that students have responsibility for their learning process and should prepare them for life-long, self-directed learning.

4.1 INSTRUCTION LEVEL AND STAFF – The provider shall have a policy that ensures recruitment of academically and professionally qualified staff to administer and manage the programme.

4.5 REVIEW OF CURRICULUM AND LEARNING MATERIALS – The provider shall put in place a mechanism for regular review of both the curriculum and instructional materials by peers and experts. The review shall focus on relevance and appropriateness of content in relation to the syllabuses and their objectives, discipline conformity and learner expectations.

6.3.1 ADMISSION INTO THE PROGRAMMES – The provider shall ensure that open and distance learning increases access and equity. In order to increase access and equity in ODL, the provider shall endeavor to reduce barriers on eligibility for admission through bridging and foundation courses.

6.3.2 DURATION AND STRUCTURES OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES – The provider shall ensure that there is flexibility in the programme structures and duration.

6.3.3 EXAMINATION REGULATIONS – The provider shall, at enrolment, inform the learner of any examinations that would be offered by external bodies and declare the requirements of the said examinations.

EVALUATION AND ASSESSMENT – The provider shall put in place appropriate assessment procedures that will ensure proper assessment of the learner’s ability and achievement and communication of the results to the learners.

7.5 EVALUATION OF STAFF – The provider shall put in place mechanisms for evaluation of both full-time and part-time staff to establish their performance and effectiveness.

The primary purpose of evaluation is to ensure quality in the entire operation of the provider all the time under changing circumstances.

8. ADVERTISING – The provider and its agents shall ensure that advertising of programmes/courses is done in a fair and ethical manner following acceptable best practices, and comply with all relevant legislation.

The provider should ensure that advertising or promotional materials give clear and accurate view of the provider, its provision, objectives and outcomes of the programme/course.

HERE IS HOW THE JESUS METHODOLOGY WORKS

TEN ROADMAPS TO UNDERSTANDING THE PERFECT HARMONY THEORY FOR BIBLE TEACHING, BIBLE TRANSLATION, AND BIBLE INTERPRETATION

The following ten thoughts can be used to understand the *Perfect Harmony Method for Bible Translation and Interpreting*:

1. The Word of God can be corrupted. In other words, the Word of God can be badly taught, translated, or interpreted according to:
 - i. **2 Corinthians 2:17 (KJV)** For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.
2. All the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God according to:
 - i. **1 Corinthians 3:19 (KJV)** For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.
3. All the Word of God is wisdom and a man devoid of the Word of God has no wisdom at all in him according to:
 - i. **Jeremiah 8:9 (KJV)** The wise *men* are ashamed, they are dismayed and taken: lo, they have rejected the word of the LORD; and what wisdom *is* in them?
 - ii. **Deuteronomy 4:5 (KJV)** Behold, I have taught you statutes and judgments, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that ye should do so in the land whither ye go to possess it.
 - iii. **Deuteronomy 4:6 (KJV)** Keep therefore and do *them*; for this *is* your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation *is* a wise and understanding people.
4. Therefore, based on number two above, since God has declared all human wisdom as foolishness, and only the Word of God is wisdom, you cannot

sensibly use foolishness to explain wisdom, neither can you use worldly inferior foolishness to explain the Heavenly superior wisdom of the Scriptures.

5. To what extent then is human wisdom excluded from any explanation of the Bible?
6. To every extent of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation according to:
 - i. **2 Peter 1:21 (KJV)** For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake *as they were* moved by the Holy Ghost.
 - ii. **Revelation 22:18 (KJV)** For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:
 - iii. **Revelation 22:19 (KJV)** And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this book.
7. Consequently, having excluded all human wisdom as a tool to explain the Word of God, we are thus left with only the Word of God to explain the Word of God.
8. The question then is: where do we find the right methodology in the Word of God that is approved of God to explain the Word of God? (cf. Matthew...an Intralingual Translation, pp. 5-7).
9. We found two illustrations of the *Perfect Harmony Theory for Bible Translation and Interpreting* in Mark 12 and Mark 15, which we will examine shortly.
10. Consequently, by using the Bible as its own interpreter, we achieve faithfulness to the source text and accuracy of expression apart from the assurance that the interpretation is not contradicted by any other verse in the entire Bible.

Perfect harmony is therefore the method by which the Word of God is allowed to interpret itself and by which the Bible interpreter successfully demonstrates the efficacy of rendering the often hidden meanings of Scripture, in other words, the

Perfect Harmony Theory explained in this book is the answer to decoding the obscurity of the Bible, which obscurity is confirmed in the following verses:

Daniel 12:4 (KJV) But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, *even* to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Matthew 13:34 (KJV) All these things spake Jesus unto the multitude in parables; and without a parable spake he not unto them:

Mark 4:12 (KJV) *That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and *their* sins should be forgiven them.*

Mark 4:34 (KJV) But without a parable spake he not unto them: and when they were alone, he expounded all things to his disciples.

John 12:40 (KJV) He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with *their* eyes, nor understand with *their* heart, and be converted, and I should heal them.

Revelation 22:10 (KJV) And he saith unto me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand.

To master the *Perfect Harmony Theory for Bible Translation and Interpreting* is to successfully blend the communicative objective of teaching, translating, and interpreting with thorough Bible scholarship enriched by research and study of the Word from Genesis to Revelation, without losing the scientific edge of Bible interpretation where scientific means that the interpretation that is finally presented is verifiable in much the same intellectual way as you can subject a text to translation analysis using proper translation assessment tools.

There must be no variation or contradiction between what is presented as meaning of the verses and what the Bible says (cf. Pryce, *Matthew...an Intralingual Translation*). Due to the verse comparison and verification that is required, the *Perfect Harmony Method* is also a tool to test *faithfulness* in Bible teaching, translation, and interpreting.

CHAPTER 23

The “Doctor of the Law” Program is NOT for the study of worldly mundane courses such as Poetry, History of Religions, Marketing, Demonology Corporate Governance, and so on and so forth. The entire “Doctor of the Law” Program is aimed at preparing the future Pastor to fulfil this particular spiritual God-assigned role of the Pastorate that is clearly recorded at **Jeremiah 3:15 (KJV)**!

Jeremiah 3:15 (KJV) And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

PROGRAM DESIGN

9. 60 credits will be 20 classes.
10. There are normally two semesters/sessions per each University calendar year beginning roughly from late August to late December, and then from February to late May.

11. The 4-year Doctor of Theology (Th.D.) degree program shall therefore take 8 university semesters where one semester is a 16-week period of 40 sessions and each class session taking 50 minutes or 1 hour 15 minutes.

The Doctor of Theology (Th.D.) will prepare you to study and gain excellent understanding in all the 66 Books of the Holy Bible as a solid spiritual foundation to a successful pastoral experience in Ministry.

In addition to the reading, study, and research of the chapters in the Curriculum that correspond to the above 66 Books of the Holy Bible, the Bible Student shall deepen his or her preparedness in Pastoral Training by electing to read and study at least five of the supplementary Christian Theological Research Textbooks of The Bible University: see chapters 3 and 15 for the list of textbooks.

INTRODUCTION TO CHAPLAINCY

1. The terms “Chaplain” and “Chaplaincy” do not exist in the entire Holy Bible from Genesis to Revelation.
2. What the corporate and secular worlds call “Chaplain” is what you already know as “Priest, Clergy, Minister, Missionary, Pastor”.
3. Therefore, a Chaplain is an ordained Priest, Clergy, Minister, Missionary, or Pastor.

4. The equivalent of the Medical Psychologist is the Christian Counsellor in the church or the Chaplain in a business enterprise.
5. When a Pastor is employed by a religious organization such as a church, to minister to the spiritual needs of the congregation, he is called a Priest, Clergy, Minister, Missionary, or Pastor.
6. However, when the same Pastor is employed by a commercial entity, a business organization, a hospital, a University, an hospice, a House of Parliament, the Army, or on a sailing ship, to minister to the spiritual needs of his clientele, then that same person is called “a Chaplain”.
7. In other words, a Priest, Clergy, Minister, Missionary, or Pastor who works outside the church, takes on the new tittle of “Chaplain”.
8. A Chaplain can be referred to as a Clergy member who is ordained to assist residents or patients in their religious and spiritual needs.
9. A Pastor whose office and wages come from a church is a Pastor, but a Pastor whose office and wages come from a company/secular business entity is a Chaplain.
10. The Christian Counsellor or the Chaplain is a specialization within the Office of the Priest, Clergy, Minister, Missionary, or Pastor.
11. Generally, therefore, one first has to become an ordained Minister before he or she can specialize as a Christian Counsellor or Chaplain.
12. The Training Program for the Priest, Clergy, Minister, Missionary, or Pastor is the entire Holy Bible from Genesis to Revelation.
13. The Training Program for the Chaplain or Christian Counsellor is a specialization within the Holy Bible.
14. Hence, the Training Program for the Chaplain requires two textbooks:
 - i. The Holy Bible, and
 - ii. A Christian Theological Research Textbook written only for training in Christian Counselling: The Counseling Manual – Case Studies, Rev. Prof. Peter Pryce, Ph.D. – ISBN 978-9988-8800-4-0 – paper edition

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CHAPLAIN

1. A Chaplain's most important job is to provide religious services, spiritual guidance, and counselling to those in need.
2. A good Chaplain engages in constant reading of the Holy Scriptures since that is the foundation and pillar of his/her Chaplaincy:
 - i. **1 Timothy 4:13 (KJV)** Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.
3. A good Chaplain performs religious rites.
4. A good Chaplain is an Anointed Teacher of the Doctrines of God and of Jesus Christ.
5. A good Chaplain conducts spiritual worship services.
6. A good Chaplain is an ordained Clergy member who provides religious services and support to people who are hospitalized, incarcerated, or unable to attend religious services because they are on military duty.
7. A good Chaplain preaches sermons to his/her clients.
8. A good Chaplain provides confidential counseling and advising on religious, spiritual, and moral matters. In the Military, Chaplains are Commissioned Officers stationed with the Army wherever they are located.
9. A good Chaplain provides confidential spiritual guidance to individuals who do not have access to formal religious services offered by their faith of choice.

MODEL TEMPLATE OF A CHAPLAIN'S WORK

1. John the Baptist was the first Chaplain of the New Testament era because he was dispensing spiritual advisement to Kings, Government Ministers, Queens, Soldiers, Pastors, Priests, Tax Collectors, Harlots, and Sinners!
2. The Chaplaincy of John the Baptist is recorded in **Luke 3:1-18 (KJV)** and reveals the prototype of the correct work of the Chaplain! The work of today's Chaplain derives from the First Chaplaincy Work of John the Baptist!
3. The Chaplain must keep a record of datelines, times, and number of sessions that he/she performs his/her duties as revealed in **Luke 3:1 (KJV)**:
 - i. **Luke 3:1 (KJV)** Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea,

and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

4. The Chaplain can do the work of a Chaplain **ONLY** after “the Word of God came unto John” as revealed in **Luke 3:2 (KJV)**! It means that it is **ONLY** after you have become deep in the Word of God that you qualify and do the work of a Chaplain. It also means that an ignorant Pastor cannot do the work of a Chaplain, same way a person who does not have a prior deep knowledge of the Word of God from Genesis to Revelation!
 - i. **Luke 3:2 (KJV)** Annas and Caiaphas being the high priests, the word of God came unto John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness.
5. The Chaplain is a Preacher of the Word of God as **Luke 3:3 (KJV)** reveals! Specifically, the Chaplain must preach for his/her hearers to hate sin, to live righteously, and to repent of the sins that they have already committed!
 - i. **Luke 3:3 (KJV)** And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins;
 - ii. **Luke 3:4 (KJV)** As it is written in the book of the words of Esaias the prophet, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.
 - iii. **Luke 3:5 (KJV)** Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be brought low; and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough ways *shall be* made smooth;
6. The Chaplain must teach Salvation of the soul as **Luke 3:6 (KJV)** reveals!
 - i. **Luke 3:6 (KJV)** And all flesh shall see the salvation of God.
7. The Chaplain uses rebukes as part of his/her instruments of Chaplaincy as **Luke 3:7 (KJV)** reveals:
 - i. **Luke 3:7 (KJV)** Then said he to the multitude that came forth to be baptized of him, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

8. The Chaplain gives spiritual direction on how to walk in the righteousness of the LORD Jesus Christ as a catalyst for inner peace and joy as **Luke 3:8 (KJV)** reveals:
 - i. **Luke 3:8 (KJV)** Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to *our* father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.
9. The Chaplain forewarns his/her clients on the spiritual dangers of living in sin and in unrighteousness as **Luke 3:9 (KJV)** reveals:
 - i. **Luke 3:9 (KJV)** And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: every tree therefore which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.
10. Here is Chaplain John engaged in Christian Counselling in **Luke 3:10-11 (KJV)**:
 - i. **Luke 3:10 (KJV)** And the people asked him, saying, What shall we do then?
 - ii. **Luke 3:11 (KJV)** He answereth and saith unto them, He that hath two coats, let him impart to him that hath none; and he that hath meat, let him do likewise.
11. In **Luke 3:12 (KJV)**, Chaplain John is performing a spiritual rite of water baptism and counselling his clients to stop stealing and to turn away from their corrupt lifestyles of taking bribes!
 - i. **Luke 3:12 (KJV)** Then came also publicans to be baptized, and said unto him, Master, what shall we do?
 - ii. **Luke 3:13 (KJV)** And he said unto them, Exact no more than that which is appointed you.
12. In **Luke 3:14 (KJV)**, Chaplain John is in his role of Chaplain but in a different context of advising the Army against their evil deeds, their violence against the unarmed, and their killing of innocent civilians!
 - i. **Luke 3:14 (KJV)** And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse *any* falsely; and be content with your wages.

13. In **Luke 3:15 (KJV)**, Chaplain John is teaching the people to correctly understand the Word of God and the work of Jesus Christ:
- i. **Luke 3:15 (KJV)** And as the people were in expectation, and all men mused in their hearts of John, whether he were the Christ, or not;
 - ii. **Luke 3:16 (KJV)** John answered, saying unto *them* all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:
14. In **Luke 3:17 (KJV)**, Chaplain John is prophesying of the evil days that await all sinful men and women in order to exhort them unto the path of righteousness!
- i. **Luke 3:17 (KJV)** Whose fan *is* in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and will gather the wheat into his garner; but the chaff he will burn with fire unquenchable.
 - ii. **Luke 3:18 (KJV)** And many other things in his exhortation preached he unto the people.
15. As you can see, in all the different roles and contexts of Chaplain John the Baptist, exhortation unto righteousness is the key to inner spiritual success, happiness, and Salvation.

The LORD Jesus Christ be with your spirit. The LORD Jesus Christ give you understanding.

CHAPTER 28

DOCTOR, HONORIS CAUSA

The Doctor, Honoris Causa of The Bible University is an Honorary Doctorate Degree. It is awarded only by recommendation and will, therefore, not be issued on a personal application.

Honorary degrees recognize those who have made profound and enduring contributions to scholarship, culture, and improved quality of life in society. Honorary degrees are academic awards given by Universities to individuals to recognize their exceptional contributions to society or lifetime achievement in their field.

Recipients of honorary degrees do not have to meet any of the typical requirements for a doctorate, such as passing examinations or completing a thesis. Honorary degrees can be conferred on people from all walks of life. There are no academic or professional privileges associated with honorary degrees. Recipients of honorary degrees can be called “Doctor” by others but should not use the title when talking about themselves, nor should it be used in written communications, including business cards except the words “Honoris Causa” or “Honorary” are written after the degree.

The recipient of an honorary degree may add the degree title post nominally, but it should always be made clear that the degree is honorary by adding "Honorary", “Honoris Causa”, or “H.C”, or “Hon” in parentheses with the degree title, for example Hon. Doctor of Theology (Hon. Th.D.), to show that the degree has not been earned through successful completion of an academic program. The degree abbreviation can be used after the recipient’s name. Recipients can also note on their résumé that they have been awarded the degree, but they should add the word “Honorary”.

The Bible University is qualified and authorized by law to award honorary degrees. The Bible University possesses a United States Patent and Trademark for its name with identification # 97075519, and is in corporate “Good Standing” status with the State of Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation. Furthermore, The Bible University is legally approved and authorized as a United States Federal

Section 501 (c) (3) Public Charity Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) with Public Charity Status 170 (b) (1) (A) (vi) and ID # EIN 82-3501141. Thus, The Bible University is exempt from Federal Income Tax under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501 (c) (3). Donors can therefore deduct contributions that they make to The Bible University under IRS Section 170. The Bible University is also qualified to receive tax-deductible bequests, devises, transfers, or gifts under Section 2055, 2106, or 2522 of the US Tax Code. God bless you as you give.

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD OF DOCTOR, HONORIS CAUSA

The Bible University may award an honorary degree to an outstanding individual who satisfies one or more of the following criteria:


1. Evidence of Professional Accomplishment: such as academic and/or industry accomplishments with sustained achievements of distinction.
2. Evidence of Influential contributions within business, government, academia, military, and/or entrepreneurialism.
3. Evidence of National/global honors awarded within discipline or interdisciplinary achievements.
4. Evidence of Commitment to serve humanity through innovative leadership.
5. Evidence of significant impact, development, and mentorship of others.
6. Evidence of demonstrated commitment to benefiting society.
7. Evidence of entrepreneurially inspired contributions.
8. Evidence of commercialization efforts that bring elements to life for positive universal influence.
9. Evidence of eminence in the course of a career, in some field of scholarship, in public service, or in an artistic, literary, governmental, religious, financial, or other endeavor.

PROCEDURE FOR THE AWARD OF DOCTOR, HONORIS CAUSA

1. Adhere to the international norms in order to pass the credibility test of awarding the Doctor, Honoris Causa, in order to pass any future test, verification, and scrutiny by possible opponents to your new title, hence:

2. Show evidence of a previous assistance and developmental donation to a Christian Project of The Bible University, for example, in Ghana.
3. Submit your CV to the Awarding Committee of The Bible University.
4. Present a record of accomplishments that the Awarding Committee can recommend to The Bible University.
5. Members of the Awarding Committee to consider your recommendation shall receive remuneration from your donation.
6. The Bible University in Ghana, based on the positive recommendation of the Awarding Committee, will then recommend you to The Bible University, USA for the award of the Doctor, Honoris Causa, and therewith present your CV and your accomplishments to humanity.





THE DOCTRINE OF THE BIBLE UNIVERSITY!

I identify thirteen foundational pillars of The Bible University Doctrine! This is our doctrine and this is where we stand in the Holy Scriptures.

- 3.** Our foundational doctrine is that there is ONLY ONE WAY to teach, to translate, and to interpret the Word of God, which is: YOU MUST TEACH THE WORD OF GOD TO AGREE WITH THE WORD OF GOD! Proverbs 21:30 (KJV), Isaiah 8:20 (KJV), John 10:35 (KJV)
- 4.** Our foundational doctrine is that: TO QUALIFY AS A MAN OF GOD, YOU MUST THINK, SPEAK, AND OBEY THE WORD OF GOD COMPLETELY TO REFLECT THAT HOLY SPIRIT LIVES IN YOU! Joshua 1:8 (KJV), John 15:7 (KJV), Colossians 1:9 (KJV)
- 5.** By means of the Word of God, we identify, analyze, dissect, point out, prove, show, expose, and overthrow evil church doctrines and practices that have no basis in the Holy Bible, that violate the Holy Scriptures, and that are contrary to the Gospel of Jesus Christ! We rebuke sharply, sparing no man or woman, to the intent "that they may be sound in the faith"! 2 Corinthians 13:10 (KJV), 1 Timothy 5:20 (KJV), Titus 1:13 (KJV)
- 6.** We judge the spiritual controversies of Jesus Christ and Apostle Paul with the Word of God Almighty! Deuteronomy 17:8 (KJV), Deuteronomy 21:5 (KJV), Ezekiel 44:24(KJV)
- 7.** We maintain The Offense of the Cross! John 6:61 (KJV), Galatians 5:11 (KJV), James 3:2 (KJV)
- 8.** We do not shy away from Bible errors and contradictions, because we have Bible theories to explain the errors, omissions, corruptions, contradictions, inconsistencies and foolishness in the Holy Bible as God-ordained spiritual seals and sieves for good purpose, and for the weeding out and cleansing of the corrupt! - 13.** We teach that the best way to obey the commandments of Jesus Christ is to correctly understand them! Nehemiah 8:3, 7, 8, 13 (KJV,) Psalm 14:2 (KJV), Isaiah 28:9 (KJV), Matthew 15:10 (KJV), Luke 24:45 (KJV)
